- Homework:
 - proper feedback=lots of work
 - feedback works
 - homeworks are a flexible tool

- Practical classes:
 - possible shift in social patterns
 - size no longer a crucial issue, not applicable to on-site teaching
 - benefit of on-line consultations?

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 - lack of interactivity
 - unwillingness to be frozen in time
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 - teachers would become redundant

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 - lack of interactivity
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- Taped lectures: why bite the bullet
 - prepared topical videolectures can be a useful tool
 - teachers still needed
 - lack of interactivity in taped lectures validated
 - ⇒ teacher must supply it elsewhere
 - great convenience for students
